January 28	ARHS FAFSA-completion event –bring completed tax return and W2 and leave w/ your FAFSA almost complete.
February 1 or 15	Financial aid application deadline at most 4yr colleges (some earlier)

March 1	UMass financial aid application deadline
April 1	ARHS Scholarship Application deadline (3:30 p.m.).

May 1	Candidate reply deadline: students must inform 4yr colleges about enrollment intentions, and

	deposit at only one college.
May 1	FAFSA filing deadline for eligibility for Mass grant, available only to Pell grant recipients
June 3	Last day of school for seniors
