Sene-Gambian Scholars Program Sponsorships and Scholarships

Amherst Regional High School has partnered with schools in Senegal and The Gambia since 2011 to provide a life-changing cultural exchange experience for high school students, promoting understanding and respect across racial, ethnic, and religious differences. To date, ARHS has sent two groups of students to West Africa and received two from Senegal.

A third cohort of ARHS students is now preparing for an exchange visit to our partner schools in February 2018. These students are busy learning about West Africa and fundraising for the program's scholarship fund. Many families cannot afford the \$3,000 cost of the trip, but we have a goal of providing enough support to enable any student willing to work the chance to go.
