- Registration for SAT Online "waitlist status" begins after late registration and continues until five days before test date.
- ACT Online registration for "stand-by" testing begins after late registration and continues until eight days before test date.
- Both waitlist and stand-by have large extra fees and no guarantees!
- All test dates are Saturdays.
- Multiple choice scores released before essay scores.
